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# 1. Introduction

We recognise the vital part that businesses have to play in increasing sustainability and protecting the environment. We also recognise our business activities may have an impact on the environment from time to time, and therefore it is our responsibility to minimise any negative impacts these activities may have and to proactively promote sustainable practices throughout the business. - Considering the environmental and ethical impact of purchasing decisions and purchasing from environmentally aware suppliers wherever practical;

- Reducing the consumption of resources through the use of electronic media wherever possible;
- Managing and disposing of all company waste in a responsible manner;
- Monitoring and reducing pollution caused as a direct or indirect result of our business operations wherever possible;
- Using all suitable opportunities to influence colleagues, clients, partners, and suppliers to improve their own environmental performance;
- Complying with all applicable legislation and regulation which relate to S-RM's environmental impacts, including measuring and reporting requirements;
- Minimising energy consumption, through collaboration with relevant stakeholders including landlords and building management and encouraging personnel to use equipment and resources in an economical manner.
- Demonstrate our desire to further embed environmental, social and governance principles into S-RM's operations and support the business's sustainability, by participating in the UN Global Compact.

S-RM will achieve these commitments through the following means:

- The implementation and maintenance of an Environmental Management System which is compliant with the requirements of ISO 14001:2015;

- Reviewing the Environmental Management System, Environmental Policy and environmental targets and objectives at planned intervals to ensure that they remain appropriate to the nature and scale of S-RM's business activities and services;
- Actively seeking opportunities for continual improvement of the S-RM Environmental Management System and encouraging colleagues, clients, partners, and suppliers to do the same; and
- Ensuring that all S-RM personnel, partners, and suppliers are aware of their responsibilities in relation to the S-RM Environmental Management System.
- Actively collaborating with S-RM's ESG advisory team and dedicated Corporate Social Responsibility Committee to ensure we are aligning to best practice and utilising in-house knowledge.
